Subject: Pay For Educational Supplements

This message has been sent to all instructional staff.

Prior to July 1, 2024, School Districts were only able to pay instructional staff an educational supplement if the degree aligned directly to the staff member's area of certification. Legislative changes now allow Districts to pay instructional staff a supplement for education beyond a bachelor's degree regardless of certification area. Educational supplements are paid as referenced below:

Degree	Supplement Amount Annually	
Bachelor's Degree + 18 Semester Hours	\$800	The 18 credit hours must be after the conferral date of the Bachelor's degree.
Master's Degree	\$2,700	
Master's Degree + 18 Semester Hours	\$3,400	The 18 credit hours must be after the conferral date of the Master's degree.
Educational Specialist Degree	\$4,400	
Doctorate Degree	\$5,400	

If you are not currently receiving an educational supplement for which you are eligible, please use the link below to submit your request with an official transcript. **Please check your paystub in Employee Self-Service prior to submitting a request to see if you are already receiving an educational supplement. This supplement is prorated, paid bi-weekly, and will show as a separate line on your paycheck.**

Request submitted by June 3, 2025, will be paid retroactively to the first day of your contract for the 2024-2025 school as long as the degree conferral date is before your first workday. Any requests with a degree conferral date during the 2024-2025 school year will be paid retroactively to the date
