Title Non-School Related Trips
Code po2341gm3.24 mc per gm updated June 3 2022
Status

The following provisions shall apply to trips out of the country and/or trips in which students and teachers voluntarily and individually participate and which are not sponsored, endorsed, or supported by the School Board or within the scope of the regular instructional program.

- (1) Trips shall be organized between the individual participants and any sponsoring agency.
- (2) The School Board shall not be involved in the curriculum, itinerary, or selection of advisors for the trip.
- (3) Promotional activities shall not include the name of the individual school or School Board.
- (4) Class time may not be used for planning or advertising such trips.
- (5) ~~Participation in such travel by employees and students shall be subject to the District's leave and attendance policies.~~

5. Non-school related trips may only be taken when school is not in session.

6. Student absences from school that result from non-school related trips will be unexcused.

7. Employees who are absent from duty due to non-school related trips will be subject to district leave policy.

8. Meeting pertaining to non-school related trips may not be held on school campus unless a use of facilities form is completed and approved.
