- 1. Why is this program being purchased? What need is the program designed to meet? Provide a description of the program and include any relevant data.**

Achieve 3000 is being purchased for High School Intensive Reading Classes. This will provide progress monitoring, lexile leveled texts for differentiated instruction, FAST Prep and text for curriculum development.

- 2. Who is the target population?**

High School Intensive Reading students. Students who are below level in reading.

- 3. Is the program in the planning or implementation stage? If it has been implemented, how long has it been in place?**

The program is in the implementation stage. The 2022-2023 year is the 5th year of implementation.

- 4. What resources are needed to support the program (e.g., staff, funding, space, time, technology, etc.)?**

The continued support of a site-based reading coach for each high school is needed for continued success. Additionally, hiring a district secondary reading coach to support the teachers. Students will need continued access to their 1-to-1 devices or computers in the classrooms.

5. What are the program's intended outcomes?

The program intended outcomes include improving students' lexile scores over time. As a lexile score grows, the student's reading comprehension skills are strengthening. Improved reading comprehension will improve reading proficiency rates.

6. How do you plan to progress monitor fidelity and effectiveness of the program?

Student usage is monitored each week. Students should complete 2 activities a week and earn a 75% first try score or higher. If a student earns four 75% or higher first try scores in a month, they will earn a monthly lexile adjustment.

7. What criteria will be used to judge the program performance?

Trends in weekly monitoring data will be analyzed to determine performance, as well as to identify areas of need for support.

8. Describe what the program must accomplish to be considered successful (Return on Investment).

To be considered successful, student lexile scores will continue to increase.
