HIGH SCHOOL HEAD COACH

Required Qualifications:

- Minimum of high school diploma or equivalent
- Florida Educator's Certificate in any subject*
- ~~First aid training concepts, injury prevention, CPR~~
- Hold and maintain a certification in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR), first aid, and the use of an automatic external defibrillator. The certification must be consistent with national evidence-based emergency cardiovascular care guidelines.
- Willingness to devote time before and after school hours

Desired Qualifications:

- Knowledge of sports theory and application
- Knowledge of concepts of physical training and/or basic kinesiology
- Trained in teaching the necessary techniques and skills
- Successful experience as a Head Coach in high school level
- Successful experience as a player or coach at the college level
- Successful experience in coaching major and minor sports

Performance Responsibilities:

- Provide leadership for the sport assigned
- Teach competitiveness and sportsmanship
- Teach skill development within athletic ability
- Plan and supervise a year-round conditioning program (when applicable)
- Plan practices, games/meets and tournament schedules
- Supervise activities within the assigned sport
- Create game plan strategies
- Encourage academics, as well as athletic, achievement
- Encourage and promote participation, positive attitude and goal setting
- Assist the Athletic Director with schedules, budgets, contracts, and busing
- Serve as liaison to parents, boosters, and media
- Maintain accurate inventory of equipment pertaining to the sport
- Assist the Athletic Director in planning and organizing of promotion and participant recruitment and recognition programs pertaining to the sport
- Perform other duties as assigned by the principal and/or designee

Exerting up to 100 pounds of force occasionally and/or up to 50 pounds of force frequently, and/or up to 20 pounds of force regularly or as needed to move objects
