- First aid training concepts, injury prevention
- Hold and maintain a certification in cardiopulmonary resuscitation, first aid, and the use of an automatic external defibrillator. The certification must be consistent with national evidence-based emergency cardiovascular care guidelines.
- Florida Educator's Certificate in any subject*
- Willingness to devote time before and after school

Performance Responsibilities:

- Supervise activities and locker room activity
- Implement program policies as set forth by head coach and principal
- Assist in team selection, paperwork, schedules, budgets and busing
- Assist with equipment/inventory and uniforms
- Teach competitiveness and sportsmanship, and encourage academic as well as athletic achievement
- Express a positive attitude at all times
- Perform other duties as assigned by the principal and/or designee
