Title and Board Action Requested

Approve the amendment to the contract and authorize the purchase of services for substitute teachers from Kelly Educational Services for \$3,283,256.

Executive Summary

The Director of Human Resources, on behalf of the Superintendent of Schools, hereby requests the Board to approve the addendum to the contract, Appendix A, with Kelly Services for an increase to substitute teacher pay rates beginning in the 2022 - 2023 school year. This increase will satisfy the new minimum wage requirement of \$15.00/hour by the year 2026 set by the state of Florida and also increase all categories of substitute pay to attract and retain the most qualified applicants to our pool of substitutes to fill vacancies and day to day absences for teachers and paraprofessionals. This Amendment to Appendix A also represents a 3% decrease in the Kelly Services fees for Hernando County Schools.
